Dear Parents of 3rd and 4th graders,

Registration is now open for the 2019 - 2020 Fleet Instrumental Music Program. Please register as soon as you are able to, so that I can start scheduling the classes for the beginning of the school year. Registration is available online at: <http://bit.ly/FleetInstrumentRegistration2019>

Your child can choose from a variety of band and orchestra instruments: violin, viola, cello, string bass, flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, and trombone. If students participate in band or orchestra, they are also eligible to sign up for the bucket drumming group, which will be scheduled after the Winter Concert. All lessons are free!

We have violins, violas, cellos and basses to rent from the school, as well as a limited number of band instruments. Once all of the instruments have been rented, you will have to rent an instrument from a music store. **First priority for school rentals will go to the students on free and reduced lunch.**

There are two stores close by that I recommend: Foxes Music (Downtown Falls Church, 416 South Washington Street, 703-533-7393) and Music and Arts (4664 King Street, Alexandria, VA - in the shopping area above TGI Friday's, 703-820-3610). I have flyers for both of those stores in my classroom. Chuck Levin's Washington Music Center (11151 Veirs Mill Road, Wheaton, MD 20902, 301-946-8808) has an excellent deal for the school year:

Your child will learn in a class of like instruments. There will be 2-10 children in each class. They will be pulled out of their classroom for a half an hour a week. Take this into consideration when enrolling your child. Learning an instrument is a fantastic opportunity for your child. They will learn a skill that can give them much pleasure throughout their life.

We give two school concerts a year - usually one in December and one in June. Very advanced band and string players may want to audition for the Junior Honors Band or Orchestra (grades 4-6). Information can be found here:
